

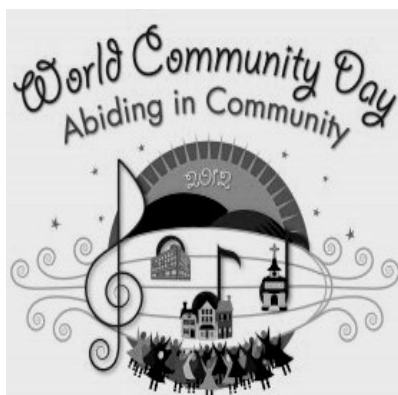

Kroger Rewards Program

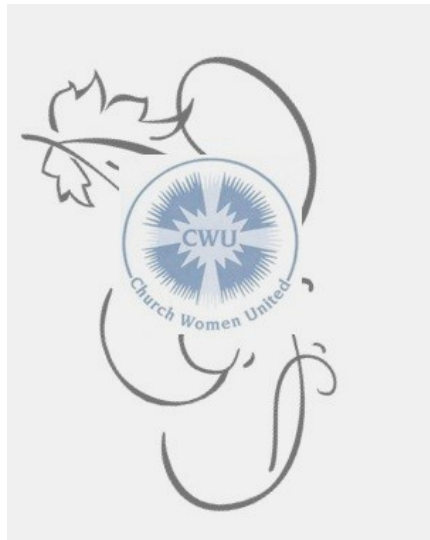

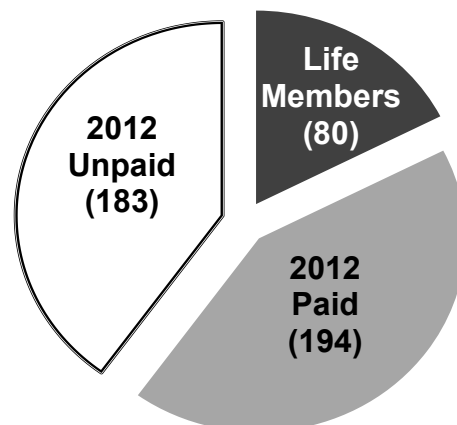
